## 6. Consultation/CoV Updates

- Gastown Public Spaces Plan - we attended an interest holder workshop at the invitation of the CoV. This is expected to go to Council this year. More details in the meeting presentation.
- CoV Vision Zero Action Planning Workshops - we attended three workshops at the invitation of the CoV. More details in the meeting presentation.
- Ontario Bikeway improvements from the Seawall to 2nd were discussed, including the road closure at 5th. From 2nd to 5th has been reopened for local traffic. Be aware of construction, and use an alternate route if work is in process.
- There was a reminder about detours associated with Cambie Bridge Seismic Upgrades, particularly along the seawall on the north side of False Creek.
