 - RATC meeting is next week

 - Great Heron Way group hasn't met for a while
 - No 2 Rd improvements, partially done
 - Concerns - lane was full of leaves and cyclists were using the street; Pedestrians and cyclists still need to look both ways; Moved crosswalk, with a merge lane for traffic, not sure if that's temporary or permanent. Need more info from city about future plans. **Action:** Need to ask Nathan about future plans for the design. Devyn and Sheryl will ask at next RATC meeting.

- Method of communication for a real-time chat - *Discord* is a good application. Action: Devyn - will ask HUB if they're ok with this type of communication.
 - More bike parking - write a letter to businesses; see if Translink can help with some funding for bike parking
 - No. 3 Rd as MUP
 - Advocate for the City of Richmond to come up with policy on detours for cycling routes while there's construction. Vancouver is good about doing that.
 - Idea - to use a Kanban board to help prioritize objectives
 - Trello - can use for free - easier to maintain than spreadsheet - Action: try out
- Topics from emails
 - Cathy Acuna retiring - leaving HUB but will volunteer as part of the North Shore Committee, middle of February
 - Highway interchange near tunnel - someone suggested that the Rice Mill Road section of MUP be built first but there are safety concerns. Goal is to have that open sooner than later.
 - Translink Cost Share Program 2026 - involves a number of Richmond projects - projected cost, over \$10 million
